

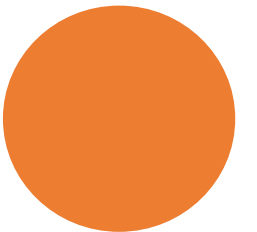
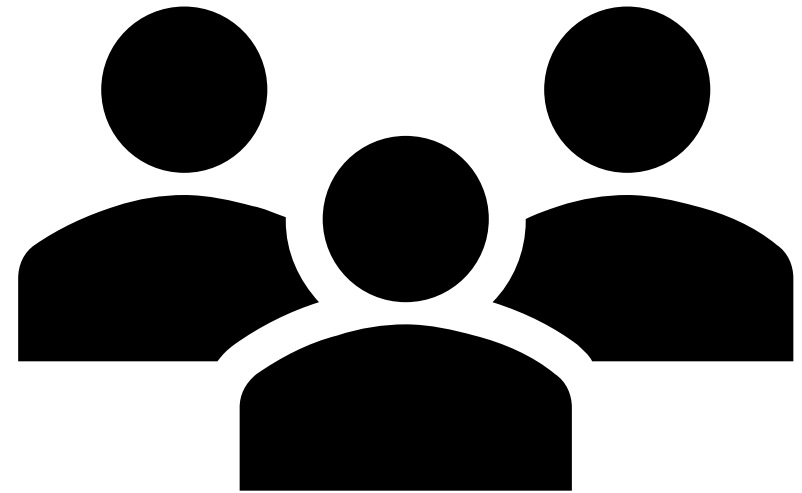


# When will we practice? – Annissa Hackney

- Audition Clinics are December 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> from 4:30 – 6:30 pm in the ET Booth Cafeteria.
  - Tryouts are December 4<sup>th</sup> beginning at 4:30pm and ending when students finish their tryout.
  - Practices will begin December 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 16<sup>th</sup> in the ET Booth Cafeteria

    - Varsity Guard will meet 6:30 – 8:30 pm
  - Practices will resume Jan 5<sup>th</sup> and run each Mondays and Wednesdays in the ET Booth Cafeteria.

# What forms do I need in order to participate?


- Students must have a current CCSD physical/consent/release packet on file. This may be completed via Canvas and the Dr. portion of the physical that is located on the Winter Guard Website. (ET Booth students will have to complete the paper copy of the consents/release packet linked on the website.)
- Students must have a current CCSD COVID Waiver on file with the EHS Eagle Band Association.
- Students who participated in the fall Marching Band season have met the above requirements. Please ensure your physical has not expired until after the first of April. Physicals are good from one year after the date they were completed.
- The online registration form should be completed to ensure UpToDate contact info.
- A payment plan must be selected, and deposit paid no later than December 11th to ensure participation.

# How much will it cost to participate in Winter Guard? – Mr. Long

- Total cost per member for the 2020-2021 season will be \$415.
  - A deposit of \$100 is due on December 11<sup>th</sup> to secure your spot.
  - Families may pay in full on December 11<sup>th</sup> if they so choose.
  - Families may select a payment plan as follows:
    - Deposit \$100 due December 11<sup>th</sup>
    - Payment 1 \$165 due January 15<sup>th</sup>
    - Final Payment \$150 due February 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Families who need a different payment plan may fill out the Family Commitment Plan linked on the indoor site listed under forms.
  - Families in hardship may apply for a scholarship from the EHS Eagle Band Association. It is expected that families participate in volunteer and fundraising opportunities to help the program raise funds for scholarships.
  - Families selecting a Family Commitment Plan or Scholarship should submit their application no later than December 11<sup>th</sup> to receive consideration.

# What does the money cover?

- This year is certainly different than most. Below are some expenses associated with the winter guard activity.
  - Adjunct Coaches
  - SAPA Circuit Fees (This went up from last year.)
  - Uniform (This will be modest this year to save cost.)
  - Cost for props and/or competition floor
  - New warmup pull over and guard bag for each member
  - Cost for choreography
  - Cost for new flag poles and materials for them
  - Cost for more sabers and rifles
  - Cost for music mix we perform to
  - Cost to assist with trailer maintenance
